September 9/10th – Auditions

September 11th - Cast list posted

September 14th - Full Cast first meeting after school

September 15th - Lincoln Theatre Booster monthly meeting at 6:30 pm in the men's dressing room

September 22nd - Drama Parent Information meeting at 6:30 pm in the rehearsal space.

September 25th – All fees (or reduction/payment plan forms) due. You will be removed from the show if this deadline is missed.

Note: Drama practices are arranged at the beginning by scene

October 16th – Lincoln Football game (?)

October 17th – Mandatory build day

October 20th - Lincoln Theatre Booster Meeting 6:30 in the men's dressing room

October 24th – EMU Drama Day

Note: In November, everyone needs to be at all rehearsals. Rehearsals usually last until 7:00 pm
****Pick Up / Drop Off Zone**** is the lot behind the PAC backstage door. Always arrange to pick up or drop off your child here. This will insure maximum safety for all involved. Also, in November practice will occur on Saturdays and Sundays. This is mandatory. 3 weeks until show time!

November 3rd – All Ad forms & money are due. Remember you must sell at least \$20 in ads or shout outs.

November 13th – All payment plans must be completed.

November 22nd – Final Show. Strike takes place immediately after the performance. No performers or crew members may leave until everything is taken down, cleaned up, and put away. This can take 3 to 5 hours. Families are encouraged to stay and help. Snacks will be served. Cast party is immediately following strike at a location to be announced later. Please note if you host the cast party you will be excused from strike.
